Basic Obedience Class Overview

Commands: always say command ONCE and then follow with NO or GOOD.

Place- no reward on place

Break- only used for place

Walk- no pulling but can have range of leash

Heel- K9 to be at your heel at all times, no pulling

Heel sit- K9 sitting at your heel

Sit- K9 must sit

Down- K9 to be in down position

Stay- K9 stays in position (sit, down, etc.) Handler returns to K9

Wait- K9 waits in position (sit, down, etc..) handler gives another command

Front- this is a come here command , K9 must return to handler in a front sit position

Leave it- K9 leaves distraction alone

Return Heel - K9 returns to sit heel position

Release- release dog from a command for free time

Remember:

Prepare yourself for training- rewards, disciplines, equipment

Always follow through- win every challenge

Timing- correct and reward in the moment

Always set a structure to follow

Tones of voice

Watch your own body language

Stay calm

Corrections:

ALWAYS be very stern with tone of voice! Never repeat commands use NO and Command.

For mouthing problems (bark, growl, biting, etc..) Use sour juices in the mouth after saying "NO" Be stern.

For jumping type problems, use a noise correction, (horn, can of coins, clicker,etc..)

Rewards:

ALWAYS use a very happy tone and reward K9 for doing good. Never repeat command use GOOD and the command.

Use food, praise and / or play

This is the start of learning to communicate and train your K9's.
